- Contra Costa County Measure X Teen Centers Social Change Partners Dr.
 Gregory Burks. Discussing the proposed Measure X Teen Center that will be built in
 East Contra Costa County. Dr. Burks provided background on the Measure X
 referendum that was passed, the Board of Supervisors designation of funds to
 create youth centers, and plans for operating. Dr. Burks solicited feedback from
 Commissioners for youth center services, operations, and amenities.
- 2. Center for Human Development: The Empowerment Program Caitlin Gulseth Empowerment Program Coordinator. Empowerment Program is a support program for LGBTQ+ youth. They meet on the 2nd and 4th Tuesdays at 430 Railroad Ave, Suite 102A Pittsburg CA, 4:30-6:30pm. Background information on Center for Human Development and the health and wellness services they have provided since 1972 was given. Focus on building healthy social and support networks.
